





















About the ME4CataLOgue project

The international professional conference ME4CataLOgue is organised within the framework of the project ME4CataLOgue (Mechanical Engineering for Catalogue) Croatian Catalogue of knowledge, skills and competences for Mechanical Engineering studies (Bachelor, Master and Doctoral study programmes) based on learning outcomes, which is a part of the IPA IV programme "Further development and implementation of the Croatian Qualifications Framework (CQF)". It has been recognized as an extremely important project which gathers as project partners all higher education institutions in the field of mechanical engineering in Croatia. The most important outcome of this project will be a Catalogue of qualifications in the field of mechanical engineering in Croatia, and one of the goals is to inform students, teachers and the general public about the benefits of applying CQF. The beneficiary of the project is Mechanical Engineering Faculty (MEF) in Slavonski Brod with the partners Faculty of Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering and Naval Architecture (FEEMENA) Split, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Naval Architecture (FAMENA) Zagreb, Faculty of Engineering (FE) Rijeka and Institute for the Development of Education (IDE). The associates in the project are Croatian Chamber of Economy (CCE), Croatian Employment Service (CES), Croatian Chamber of Mechanical Engineers (CCME), Technology Development Center - Development Agency of Brod-Posavina County (TDC), Student associations and Alumni associations at 4 partner higher education institutions (HEI). The project is being implemented from August 19, 2013 to February 18, 2015 in Croatia, Brod - Posavina County, Primorje-Gorski Kotar County, Split - Dalmatia County, Zagreb County. Call for participation

The international professional conference ME4CataLOgue aims to gather all stakeholders at one place, from the representatives of ministries, agencies, companies, higher education institutions (HEIs) to experts, teachers and students who are involved in the development and implementation of CQF. The main purpose of this Conference is to promote higher education reform which is a part of information, dissemination and promotion activities related to the implementation of CQF in higher education sector in Croatia with particular reference to the field of mechanical engineering. Furthermore, the aim of the Conference is to inform the general public (at the national and international level) with the scope and objectives of the project. The Conference will serve as a platform for the exchange of best practices between experts from different countries and national stakeholders, particularly students, academic and administrative staff, as well as employers. The expected number of participants is 80 persons. The planned duration of the conference is 2 days. During the Conference an open expo about project (overview of implemented activities) will be set up. The Conference proceedings containing all submitted and accepted professional papers from Croatia and abroad will be published and distributed to Conference participants. The second day of the Conference will provide the opportunity for participants to take part in social activity. Brod-Posavina County tour has been designed to enhance networking between stakeholders and for exploring the history and culture of the Brod-Posavina County. The conference will take place at the Mechanical Engineering Faculty in Slavonski Brod, on 4 and 5 December 2014.

- ✓ implementation of soft skills, such as leadership, team building, critical thinking, etc. into study process of mechanical engineers
- ✓ implementation of innovative educational framework for producing the next generation of engineers, such as learn by doing, learn together, project based learning, CDIO, TEAL, iLABS,
- ✓ design and tracking of follow-up indicators in quality assurance of education process
